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Motorcycle futures market overview

The UK employment rate is fluctuating slightly and estimates for July shows an increase. Annual growth in pay was 7.8% in Q2, the highest regular annual growth since comparable records began in 2001, with bonuses it was 8.2%, (affected by the NHS one-off bonus payments June). Good news for those getting it and giving hope that for some the spending on things like motorcycles might not be hit as hard as recent doom and gloom might suggest. Although all this could be offset by increased interest rates. Any small sign, if any, of recovery is still small and in no way has yet indicated a trend. With the seasonal slower times around the corner, it's not the time to get complacent and the latest registration figures from the Motorcycle Industry Association, (July), do not make positive reading. Around a 1,000 less, or 9.1%, with the year to date -3.6% that in real numbers is 2,689 less. Not the best start to the second half of the year, we would expect to see leisure motorcycles doing well through the summer months, but has the mixed weather had some effects on sales?

As the industry starts to settle back to the type of mix seen before external forces changed what was sold for a couple of years. 2024 should start see a more realistic comparison to this year for numbers, as the trade returns to something more recognisable to the pre-covid 2019 market. In reality an election in the UK that is pointing to a quantum shift could rock the boat and don't forget the US elections on the larger global economy.

All this is relevant to the short term used market, but as mentioned on a regular basis this product is manly used in the formulation of future values for PCP types of agreements. Long term the end of contract returns tend to space out at times different to the original registrations as they are not immediately sold or returned by the customer. So disposal by the finance house can also be delayed, so supply in the used market from that source is more consistent than the original new sales patterns and therefore future predictions are also more stable and expectations remain for strong long term values.
